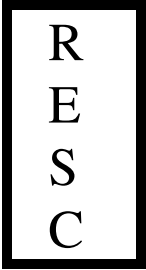

In these competitions over the years, the ensemble has merited numerous First Place Trophies with consistent ratings of “Superior” in the High School Show Choir Division. At Pigeon Forge, SUAVE also won the Overall Choral Award for scoring the highest number of points of all high school choral ensembles.

At the “Music Showcase Festivals” in Cincinnati in 1997, Cedar Point in 1999, and in Cincinnati in 2001 and 2007, the ensemble also won the Grand Sweepstakes Award for scoring the highest number of points of all ensembles participating in the three-week festival.

The St. Ursula Academy Vocal Ensemble performed at Carnegie Hall in New York City, New York in June of 1999 and 2001, in November of 2004, and again in January of 2007.
