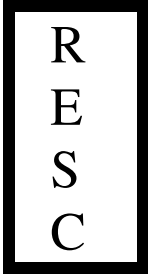

RECOLLECTIONS OF A WWII INTERROGATOR

JOHN DOLIBOIS

HERMANN GOERING WAS AT THE DOOR. The German officer clicked his heels. Commander of the German Luftwaffe, a marshal of the Third Reich during World War II, Goering - one of Adolph Hitler's most trusted senior officers - had been captured and faced trial for war crimes. The memory remains vivid for John Dolibois.*

John E. Dolibois, soldier, educator, and diplomat, will be the RESC speaker March 20th. He will tell about his World War II experiences, including the International War Crimes Trials where interrogated such Nazi War Criminals as Hermann Goering, Streicher, Ribbontrop and others.

Mr. Dolibois was born in Luxembourg and came to the United States in 1931 at the age of 13. He attended elementary school in Akron, Ohio and graduated with honors from Miami University in 1942. Shortly after graduation, he entered military service and was commissioned a second lieutenant. (Continued on page 2)

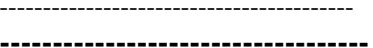

After learning of his knowledge of German, he was transferred to Military Intelligence, and at the age of 26 was assigned to the International War Crimes Trials in Nuremberg.

In 1981 he was named Ambassador by President Reagan and served as U.S. Ambassador to Luxembourg.

Prior to becoming an ambassador he was at Miami University for 34 years, and served in many positions including Vice President for University Relations from 1967 to early retirement in 1987. He had been affiliated with Proctor & Gamble before joining Miami University. Mr. Dolibois has had many honors and awards too numerous to mention in this article.

He and his wife Winifred currently reside here at Evergreen.
