DORIS DAY'S SUCCESS STORY

Lynne Petty-Roth of the Cincinnati Public Library will present to us the Doris Day Story from her early years in Cincinnati (Evanston) to Hollywood, including her career as a vocalist and an international movie star, also her activities as an animal activist.

Doris borrowed her stage name from a song **Day By Day** rather than use her given name of Doris Mary Ann von Kappelhoff. She sang with the Bob Crosby Band and with the Les Brown Band. An interesting note is as a young girl Doris wanted to become a dancer. She started taking dancing lessons at the age of 6, however, at the age of 13 her leg was injured in a car accident preventing her from pursuing a dancing career. After this Doris became interested in singing. Under the guidance of Grace Raine, a voice coach, Doris began to improve and develop her own style of singing.

We all know the rest; Doris went on to record 29 studio albums and over 50 hit songs such as:

- Lullaby of Broadway
- Teachers Pet
- Sentimental Journey
- Que Sera, Sera

Doris also made over 30 films among those being:

- On Moonlight Bay
- Pillow Talk (Academy Award Nomination)
- The Pajama Game

Lynne will talk about the death of Doris Day's third husband Marty Melcher and the mismanagement or embezzlement of her life's earnings.

Our speaker Lynne Petty-Roth is native to this area having attended Northern Kentucky University. Lynne did graduate work at the University of Indiana and was awarded a Masters Degree in Library Science. She specializes in adult services at the library. Her presentations are about famous Ohio personalities as part of the Library's Speaker Program. Incidentally Lynne's birth is the same as Doris Day's, April 3rd.

GENE GARDNER

“I believe parenting is one of the most important things we can do, yet it is something many of us poorly prepare for. If we can transfer the best parenting information available into the minds and hearts of parents in a timely and easy-to-use format, it will be better for the child, the parents and the community.”

This award is presented to “Gene” Gardner for founding **Every Parent’s Library**, this unique concept to better society by improved parenting. He conceived this program that provides high quality timely guidance to parents, by videos and personal follow up. Also, he assembled individuals and institutions to bring it to fruition.

A Short History of Every Parent’s Library

The inspiration for **Every Parent’s Library** stemmed from these powerful ideas:

1. Of all human activities, parenting is a critically important task. Yet, parent training is rarely sought out or proactively provided by our most common institutions.
2. In our fragmented dual income society, the extended family and the close-knit neighborhood has nearly vanished as a support network for new parents.
3. The medical and scientific community has thoroughly documented what has been termed “Infant Brain Research”. This shows that when an infant is talked to, sung to, and played with, in the first 18 months of his/her life, changes occur in the development of his/her brain. These changes have a profound positive impact on the character of that child during the teen years.

From these concepts **Every Parent’s Library** was created using videos and follow-up contacts to help children learn everywhere. For more info see web site www.everyparentslibrary.org.

Gene has a Masters of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering from Penn State University in 1962. Gene retired from Procter and Gamble in Cincinnati after a 31 year career. Gene and his wife Kay are character coaches for the Winners Walk Tall program, and both serve as weekend presenters and leadership for the National Marriage Encounter. He is the area volunteer coordinator and a public speaker for Heifer International, and the founder of **Every Parent’s Library**.

TOUR OF THE MASON WATER RECLAMATION PLANT

Fourteen **hearty and hardy** members braved the winter-like weather to tour the plant, April 29. It was state of the art, in service for just two years. It is computerized and automatic in operation. If a problem occurs, the SCADA system will alarm to whomever is on call during off hours. It operates 24/365, while regular plant people are there five days a week, 40 hours. The plant was immaculate and the tour guides very proud and enthusiastic. Water is not safe to drink, but they do pump it to the Heritage golf course if requested. They have been visited by engineers from 36 states and several foreign countries such as Kuwait and South Korea. Five CPD certificates were handed out.
