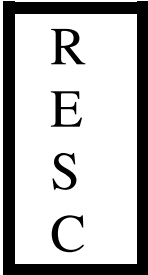

LOOKING BACK; DONALD HARVEY, ANGEL-OF-DEATH SERIAL KILLER

Bruce Martin, RESC member, will discuss his latest book written with Defense Attorney, William Whalen: "Defending Donald Harvey: The Case of America's Most Notorious Angel-of-Death Serial Killer." It's the story of the man, a nursing assistant, who killed 59 people in Ohio and Kentucky. The book explores the mind and making of an American serial killer and how it created ethical dilemmas for the legal profession.

Bruce began his professional career as a chemical engineer at Procter and Gamble. He's a dedicated teacher and has been on the faculty of three universities: Auburn, Ohio State and the University of Cincinnati. Currently he moderates a course entitled "I Love A Mystery" for the Institute for Learning in Retirement at U.C.

He's the author of "Martin's Mini Mysteries" and co-author of "Killing Is Murder" by Pleiades. He and his wife Phyllis, also an author, live in Cincinnati.
